The Teacher of the Deaf position involves teaching school subjects to Deaf and Hard of Hearing children in a Kindergarten to Grade 12 bilingual-bimodal-bicultural school. It includes responsibility for instruction, learning and assessment of students following curriculum as established by the Department of Education and Training.


